A Litany & Prayer for Father's Day

Like Mother's Day, the first known celebration of a day honoring fathers was born out of a Methodist church. Grace Clayton, who was mourning the death of her father, heard about a nearby mining accident that killed hundreds of men—many of whom were fathers—and asked her church to create a special service to honor them. On July 5, 1908, Williams Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church South held the service that paved the way for Father's Day.


