Visioning Update

The team appointed by the Church Council is currently working with the Ministry Leadership Center assessing the culture of Bartlett UMC. In particular, we are looking at the bonds within the congregation and our willingness for adapting to a changing culture in the world. In January we will do a deep dive into the Bartlett community which is our primary mission field.

The team is also developing a survey for the entire congregation. We considered using one from the Ministry Leadership Center but concluded we prefer to develop our own for Bartlett UMC. Our expectation is the survey will be completed online primarily, but there will be hard copies available for those who prefer pen and paper. We want to make it succinct in hopes of getting a good response rate. We hope to send the survey in December with a cutoff date for submissions to be determined.

Obviously, one of the purposes of a survey is to solicit your opinion. That inevitably brings your personal preferences into play. As your pastor, I am challenging us to focus on what we feel God is calling us to do and to be. Sometimes, these may align with "what I like." Other times that may not be the case. We must never forget that we are seeking GOD'S VISION for BUMC. It is far more important to answer the question "What does God want for us as a congregation serving the Bartlett community and the world?" than it is to answer the question "What do you or I want?" Please prayerfully keep this in mind as you respond to the survey.
