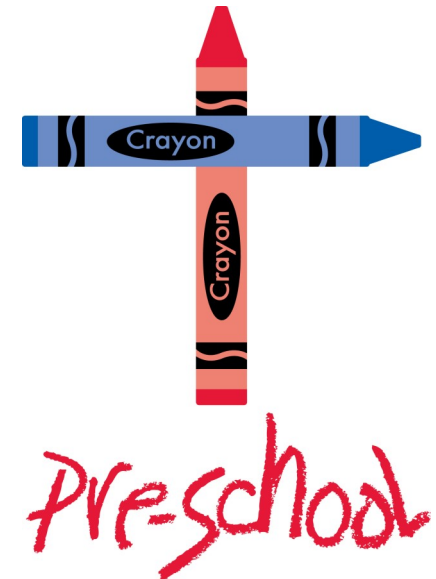
**Program:** For Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4, we offer Monday-Wednesday-Friday or Tuesday-Thursday 9:00-12:00 or 9:00-2:30. For older 4-year olds and 5-year olds, we offer a 5-day pre-school transition program from 9:00-12:00 with the option of up to 3 afternoons until 2:30.

**Registration:** The end of January and early February mark the beginning weeks of registration for the following school year. Church members are given first priority, followed by students currently enrolled in our preschool and KDO programs. Exact registration dates can be obtained on our website or by emailing the pre-school office.

**Fees:** A non-refundable registration fee of \$100.00 for new students or \$75.00 for returning students, as well as one month's advance tuition, (applied to last month of school year which is May) is due in order for your child to be fully registered. The advance tuition is refundable until August 1st. **All paperwork and fees** are due at registration including medical releases and emergency information. Immunization records are due by August 1st. (See inside for tuition prices).



The decision for parents to find a quality pre-school experience for their child's early childhood development is an important one. Our goal is to be a bridge between parental guidance and a well rounded preparedness for Kindergarten. Parents are always welcome to visit our classrooms.

### Mission Statement

*Bartlett United Methodist Pre-School was initially established in 1968 to provide a Christian environment in which young children might gain developmental experiences that will enable them to grow emotionally, socially, physically, cognitively, and spiritually. Today, we strive to meet the same goals, as did the founders, while maintaining current requirements for an outstanding Pre-School. Knowing that children develop at different rates, we encourage and teach all children at levels where their greatest potential can be reached. Basic skills are fundamental in our curriculum which aid in laying the foundation for a strong academic career in higher school achievement.*

## Curriculum

Monthly themes are the basis of a developmentally appropriate curriculum which includes language arts, math, social studies, science, art, music, physical education, Bible stories, and personal safety. Goals are set and incorporated into our lesson planning to meet the following developmental areas:

- Love for God and others
- Confidence and self reliance
- Emotional and social behavior that is acceptable to himself/herself and to others
- Fine motor and gross motor skills
- Awareness of his/her body and the need for good hygiene, nutrition and exercise
- An appreciation of art, music, and literature
- Cognitive skills for Kindergarten readiness
- Individual creativity
- Independent thinking skills
- Appreciation for multi-cultural backgrounds

**Centers:** Each classroom is designed with learning centers and teacher-directed activities. Centers include: math, blocks/construction, art, music, library, manipulatives/puzzles, science, dramatic play and other seasonal set-ups to spark creative play. Teacher-directed activities include instruction in number/letter recognition, writing, phonetic awareness, fine motor/cutting skills, science experiments, cooking, and more.
